



Host Family Agreement

Yeshiva of Greater Washington-Tiferes Gedaliah (YGW) is responsible for the students in the Out-of-Town Student Program (OSP) at all times. The host family serves as representatives of YGW. The primary role of YGW is to support the host family in this effort. The primary role of the host family is to help their boarder integrate into their family and the community, and to provide stability, supervision, and guidance in a welcoming Torah environment. They will also reinforce YGW's regulations by bringing violations of policy to the administration's attention.

The purpose of this agreement is to help clarify the responsibilities of the Host Family.

Host Parent Responsibilities:

1. Provide stability, supervision, and guidance to the OSP student;
2. Maintain appropriate sleeping quarters and storage space for the OSP student;
3. Keep track of the OSP student at all times when they are not at a school supervised event or program;
4. Make alternate sleeping arrangements for OSP student when the family is away and school is in session;
5. Provide OSP student with all necessary meals and food;
6. Provide transportation to and from school, health care, and school activities;
7. Integrate the OSP student into the family as much as possible;
8. Communicate with OSP manager in a timely manner about OSP student's violations of the student code of conduct;
9. Provide reasonable access to YGW staff to visit the OSP student at the home;
10. Participate in OSP Host Family orientation training; and
11. Respect the privacy of the OSP student and adhere to the mitzvah of *Shmiras Halashon*.
