As a student at YGW, I understand that I represent my family and Klal Yisroel. My conduct should reflect this at all times as outlined in the following statements:

1. I will do my best to arrive on time ready to learn with zerizus (alacrity) and charitzus (diligence).
2. I will respect the decorum of the yeshiva hallways as a Makom Torah where learning occurs by walking calmly and with dignity, and by keeping the building as neat as possible.
3. I will respect YGW property and not damage the building or furnishings.
4. I am responsible for my classwork, homework, and all books and materials.
5. I will treat the students, staff members, Rabbeim, and the General Studies teachers in YGW with respect.
6. I understand the talmid attire code and will follow it at all times.
7. I will use appropriate language and tone to settle any problems and differences. If this does not work, I will seek a rebbe, teacher, or staff member to help me.
8. I understand that cell phones and media players are prohibited to use during all school hours.
9. I understand that there is no tolerance for fighting, cursing, or showing disrespect to anyone.
10. I may not leave the school premises without permission.
11. I understand that there is no tolerance for bullying another student.
12. I have read and understand the YGW Student Expectations Rubric which will be a part of my final grade.
13. I understand that adhering to this Code of Conduct will enable me to continue on the path of becoming a Ben Torah, and enable me to succeed and grow as a Jew, a student, and a mentsch.

YGW Student Expectations Rubric

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Timeliness	The student is seated at his desk when the bell rings.	The student is tardy. Up to three (3) minutes late.	The student is more than three (3) minutes late and missed the opening of the lesson.
Readiness	Student brought the needed and expected supplies for class.	The student forgot something. They needed to go back to their locker and get something.	The student did not bring the needed materials to school and is unprepared for class.
Homework	The student completed the homework and is ready to turn it in.	The student did some of the homework, but it's not complete.	The student is not able to turn in any homework.
Attention	The student is engaged. They listen, take notes, ask questions as needed, and complete the class work.	The student is learning some of the time, but is distracted or distracting to others.	The student was present, but their mind was somewhere else today.
Staying Power	The student is engaged for the entire lesson, taking only brief breaks if needed.	The student's breaks are a little too frequent and/or extended.	Breaks are long and frequent.
Teamwork	The student acts as a team player in the classroom.	The student acts as a team player some of the time.	Today was a difficult day. The student distracted other people from learning.
Respect	The student follows the classroom Procedures & Expectations (P & E).	The student followed some of the class P & E.	The student needs to review the class P & E.
