



Out-of-Town Student Program (OSP) Family Agreement

We are excited that you have chosen to learn with us at the Yeshiva of Greater Washington-Tiferes Gedaliah. In order for this to be a successful experience, there are certain responsibilities that the OSP student and their family must fulfill. We expect all students and their families to adhere to the policies of the Student and Parent Handbook and the OSP Handbook. The purpose of this agreement is to clarify those responsibilities and highlight a few key items that impact the student's relationship with their host family.

OSP Student Responsibilities:

1. Maintain proper conduct at all times (i.e. dress code, social activities, and curfews) in accordance with the Student and Parent Handbook and the OSP Handbook;
2. Maintain the cleanliness of bedroom, personal space, and common spaces you have used;
3. Be respectful of the host family, in speech, tone, and attitude;
4. Be reasonable in usage of the family equipment, including telephone, television, and other appliances;
5. Do your own laundry;
6. Take an active role in the family chores and responsibilities;
7. Let the host family know where you are at all times;
8. Respect the privacy of the host family and adhere to the mitzvah of *Shmiras Halashon*;
9. Be aware that the host family's responsibility to the school includes informing the appropriate administrators at YGW of any violation of the Student and Parent Handbook and the OSP Handbook.

OSP Parent Responsibilities:

1. Pay host family in a timely manner per the housing agreement, including supplying a security deposit of \$500 at the beginning of the year;
2. Provide all the student's school supplies and non-food provisions;
3. Schedule and cover all travel costs for the student between the host family home and their home;
4. Ensure proper medical coverage for the child and provide documentation to the school and host parents before the student's arrival;
5. Reinforce Host Family and YGW rules with the child;
6. Communicate with the host parents on a regular basis, at least every 3 weeks;
7. Be aware that the host family's responsibility to the school includes informing the appropriate administrators at YGW of any violation per the Student and Parent Handbook and the OSP Handbook.
