

Madrich/a **Yeshiva of Greater Washington –Tiferes Gedaliah**

The role of a Madrich/a is to help enrich the Out-of-Town student experience by acting as a resource, role model, counselor, and friend. The Madrichim are also responsible for creating programming for the students outside of school hours and helping them with the basics.

The Madrich/a is supervised by the OSP Manager.

Responsibilities include –

- Contact OOT students prior to the start of the school year for the purpose of making a personal connection as well as answering questions
- Serve as resource and a counselor for OOT students during non-school hours
- Plan and execute monthly and weekly OSP student activities
- Be in regular contact with each OOT student, but talk with them no less than once a week
- Always act as a role-model
- Meet regularly with the OSP Manager to keep him/her informed on the students and the program
- Assist with ensuring that program rules are followed by all OOT students
- Other Duties as assigned
